Matt Bronson serves as Assistant City Manager for the City of San Mateo, California where he provides support to the City Council and City Manager and oversees the City's economic development, sustainability, communications, volunteer, and downtown parking and maintenance programs. Bronson recently served as the interim director of the Community Development Department and previously served as an interim manager in the Public Works Department overseeing street and facilities maintenance operations and downtown parking. Prior to joining San Mateo in 2010, Bronson served in the County Administrator's Office in Marin County, California from 2003 to 2010 and also worked for the City Manager's Office and Budget and Evaluation Office in the City of Charlotte, North Carolina from 1999-2003.
