MCCA is a professional association of Chief police executives representing the largest cities in the United States, Canada and the UK. MCCA membership comprises Chiefs and Sheriffs of the sixty-six largest law enforcement agencies in the United States, nine largest in Canada and two in the United Kingdom. They serve 89.9 million people (69.5 US - 10.5 Canada – 9.9 UK) with a sworn workforce of 239,063 (161,664 US, 20,506 Canada, 56,893 UK) officers and non-sworn personnel.

MCCA played a valuable feedback role for the BJA Executive Session on Police Leadership. We presented early results of our work at a MCCA meeting in 2012. We also polled its members to test their agreement with our core hypotheses about the direction of policing and the overall challenge for future leaders.
